



JOB TITLE: Tire & Bin Maintenance

REPORTS TO: Maintenance/Mechanic Supervisor

SUMMARY: Replaces and repairs vehicle tires, bins, and roll-offs; uses welder for repairs; paints bins, roll-offs, and vehicles; readies bins and roll-offs for delivery.

ESSENTIAL DUTIES AND RESPONSIBILITIES include the following, but not limited to:

- Replaces tires on vehicles, equipment, bins, and roll-offs
- Repairs tires when required
- Maintains onsite tire inventory and reports count to Supervisor
- Uses welder to make necessary repairs or add gravity locks, etc.
- Paints bins, roll-offs, and vehicles when needed
- Responsible for cleanliness of work area and returning tools/equipment to proper storage daily
- Applies stickers on bins and roll-offs
- Adheres to all safety procedures
- Attends/holds mandatory safety meetings, which may be scheduled outside regular hours
- Performs other duties as assigned

REQUIRED QUALIFICATIONS:

- 1-3 year's welding experience

EDUCATION AND/OR EXPERIENCE:

- High school diploma or equivalent;
- 1 year welding experience or equivalent
