

**JOB TITLE:** Truck & Line Mechanic

**REPORTS TO:** Maintenance/Mechanic Supervisor

**SUMMARY:** Maintains and repairs all vehicles, machinery, and operational equipment including engines, hydraulic motors, conveyor systems, compactors, balers, strapper, and production machines; completes and files paperwork on maintenance and repairs.

## ESSENTIAL DUTIES AND RESPONSIBILITIES include the following, but not limited to:

- Keeps vehicles and machinery operational
- Completes regularly scheduled maintenance on vehicles and machinery by performing tune-ups, lubes chassis, oil changes, replacing filters, greasing, etc.
- Makes repairs based on Drivers Daily Vehicle Inspection Reports
- Reviews repair orders, conducts inspections, replaces parts & components, repairs body damage, repairs electrical & mechanical malfunctions
- Dismantles & reassembles engines and machinery to repair defects
- Repairs vehicle body damage
- Uses pneumatic tools
- Documents maintenance and repair work for federal/state regulated recordkeeping
- Responsible for cleanliness of work area and returning tools/equipment to proper storage daily
- Assists with customer site machinery installs, as needed
- Provides maintenance for customer leased machinery, as needed
- Provides roadside mechanical assistance, as needed
- Adheres to all safety procedures
- Attends mandatory safety meetings, which may be scheduled outside regular hours
- Performs other duties as assigned

## **REQUIRED QUALIFICATIONS:**

- Must have 1-5 years Mechanic experience; Mechanic certificates preferable
- Must have a valid driver's license
- Must be DMV insurable

## **EDUCATION AND/OR EXPERIENCE:**

- High school diploma or equivalent;
- 1-5 year's Mechanic experience
